The vision for the Darren J. and Kirsten D. Clerkin Endowed Scholarship Fund is to provide a scholarship for students that are active participants or members in a multicultural student organization, multicultural Greek organizations, or a similar registered student organization that aims to help students create community around a common racial, ethnic, or cultural identity. Awards will be considered by the Selection Committee and reviewed on an as-needed basis. Recipients will be selected based on merit and by the committee that consists of Multicultural Center staff and the Office of the Vice President for Student Affairs.

Eligibility

Candidate for this fund must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- A minimum grade point average of 3.0
- Must demonstrate financial need

Hours Completed Approved/Denied

- A grade level of at least a rising Junior or Senior
- Must be a member or active participant in a Multicultural Student Organization, multicultural Greek organization, or a similar registered organization that aims to help students create community around a common racial, ethnic, or cultural identity.

Students can receive this scholarship one time during their educational career at Illinois State.
